# Juneau Soccer Club—Registration Information for September, 2008

## Changes from last year:

Several changes have happened over the past year, which affect the Club's budget and operating procedures. First, the local school district decided to fund partially the high school soccer program for the first time. This lowers the Club's costs, since in the past we were responsible for 100% of the cost of high school soccer. Second, the Dimond Park Field House is now available for indoor practice (hooray!). However, this raises our costs since the hourly cost of DPFH is significantly more than the gym time fees we were paying before. Third, the JSC Board has decided to normalize costs across our various programs so that one age group is not subsidizing another. The net effect of these changes on fees:

- The full membership fee has decreased from \$375 to \$325. \$200 is required upon registration, the balance by January 31.
- HS players who don't have a competitive team can pay a reduced fee (\$200) that covers training (ATP, Skills, GK) but no Sunday/Saturday soccer (team practice).
- The high school program participation fee will be lower this year (\$400 as of this writing, down from \$485. This fee collected in March, 2009 through JDHS).

We are also adding a training program to introduce club soccer to U8/U9 boys and girls.

**Fundraising:** we are changing the fundraising paradigm. The Club will offer the same fundraising opportunities as last year. However, monies raised from Club fundraisers will not be applied directly to Club membership fees. Individual player accounts will be tracked by competitive teams, as they are currently, and the Club will track fundraising by team only. Players can arrange with their team to use funds in their team account to pay Club fees beyond \$200. In addition, the high school program ad fundraiser will be dedicated to funding high school player fees/program only.

## FAQ for those new to the Juneau Soccer Club (JSC):

**What is JSC?** JSC is a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation dedicated to promoting competitive youth soccer in Juneau as well as JDHS interscholastic soccer. We are volunteer-run, with a paid Director of Coaching and bookkeeper and volunteer board of directors, team coaches and team managers.

**What is our fiscal year/season?** Our 'season' runs from October 1 through September 30 of every year. New members may join at any time.

**What programs does JSC offer?** JSC offers boys' and girls', age-based competitive teams (U12 and older) with team practice on weekends. We also offer a comprehensive training program: Skills (all ages), Goalkeeping (U10 and older) and Advanced Training (U12 and older), which sessions are held on weekday evenings—see the **Schedules** page of our website for more information. U10/U11 also includes weekend development practice sessions. JSC hosts regional mini-tournaments and 6v6 weekends. Competitive teams often travel for tournament play 'outside' and at State Cup in August.

**What do membership fees pay for?** As a non-profit, JSC fees are designed to cover our costs only. The largest costs are facility rental (Dimond Park Field House) and training (coaching). Competitive team travel expenses are **not** covered by JSC membership fees. **Scholarships are available**--see **Membership** page on our website. We also offer fundraising opportunities for members (calendar sales, raffle, etc.).

**Does JSC have other sources of income?** Yes, including grants from the Juneau CBJ Youth Activity Board (YAB), corporate donations, and small amounts from other sources.
