

Explanation of Fee Structure for 2011-2012 Juneau Soccer Club Season

Membership fees support the year-round club program, which includes Advanced Training Program, Skills Clinics, Goalkeeper Training, Weekend Soccer, summer field rental fees, as well as player's insurance and club fees to Alaska Youth Soccer Association.

Full Membership fee of \$350 applies to all players in the JSC 1998 – 2001 age brackets. In order to participate in any JSC sponsored event, a player must have paid an initial Membership fee of \$200 and submitted it with a completed registration form. The balance of the membership fee (\$150) is due by December 15th and members may pay by credit card or check. During that extended time, the player can earn the balance of their fees through club-sponsored raffle ticket, calendar and/or Goal Card sales. All competitive team players will have team and individual accounts to post fund raising revenue, etc. Returning players with balances in their team accounts may use that balance to help pay their fees, including the initial \$200 fee.

Fundraising Raffle/Goal Card/Calendar Sales: Club fundraisers are run at cost (all profits to the players), and a player's share of a sold item's price ranges from 50% to 90% depending on the fundraiser. Teams are responsible for distributing fundraising materials (e.g. goal cards) and collecting funds raised while tracking player sales and earnings. Teams remit fees owed by players as well as fundraiser costs to the club and retain the balance in the players' team account. (Due to legal requirements, raffle proceeds run through the club gaming account, and the club distributes profits to the teams for allocation to the players. The club may retain player profits from the raffle up to the player's unpaid fee balance, if any.)

Limited membership gives JSC some ability to recognize and accommodate unique registration circumstances. Usually, it applies to NEW members who have not been part of JSC previously and are joining after April 1st of the year. Specifics can be found in the JSC Policies & Procedures.
